1. **Application form**. The file should be labeled with the full last name and the first and middle initials, in English. For example, Ivanova N.V.application.doc. **Deadline: July 1, 2019.**

- 2. Your Article. The document should be labeled with the full last name and the first and middle initials, in English. For example: Ivanova N.V.doc Deadline: August 1, 2019.
- 3. **Documentation of Payment of Registration Fee.** Please send scanned copies of the receipts. **Deadline: August 1, 2019.**

Within 5 days of receiving the application, conference participants will receive a decision regarding acceptance by email.

Requirements for Formatting the Article

The text must be typed in Word. The length of the text can be up to double-spaced 15 pages with left margins of 3 centimeters and other margins of 2 centimeters. The font should be Times New Roman, 14 point. The title of the article should be center justified and bolded. Paragraphs should be indented 1 centimeter and otherwise left-justified. Latin taxon names should be italicized. The first time a species if mentioned, name the author. Tables should be labeled with the word "Table" on the left and then the title of the table. Drawings and photographs should be inserted into the Word text and should be clearly attributed to their creators in the text and format references as shown in Figure 1 or Figure 2. All lines and points in the figures should be clearly visible and should not merge when the size of the image is decreased.

The structure of the article should be as follows:

Yes/No

- Last Name, First Name, Middle Name--completely bolded, italicized and right-justified.
- Academic degree, academic position, institution—italicized and right-justified.
- Article Title—center-justified, capitalized and bolded. The title should be in English. For foreigners it is not necessary to submit the title in Russian and Kyrgyz as well, but applicants can also provide Russian and Kyrgyz translations.
- Abstract of no more than 10 lines, key words in English. Foreign applicants can submit the abstract and key words in Russian and Kyrgyz as well, but are not required to do so.
 - Text of the article
- Reference in the text to cited literature are given in square brackets, as far as the source is mentioned.
- Bibliography: For books: last name and initials of the author, full titles, place of publication, publisher, year of publication, volume or issue and total number of pages; for periodicals: the surname and initials of the author, the name of the journal, the year of publication, volume, number, first and last pages of the article; References to books translated into Russian should be accompanied by references to the original edition with their publication information.

REGISTRATION FEE:

Participants from abroad: \$50

Participants from Kyrgyzstan: 1000 som

Registration fees are intended to cover the costs of printing and publishing and sending the special edition to the authors. One copy of the journal is sent per published article, regardless of the number of authors.
